

## Build a Bouquet Card – Mother's Day or General



Color Scheme: Crumb Cake, So Saffron, Calypso Coral, Crisp Cantaloupe, Wild Wasabi

### **Supplies:**

Stamps: Build a Bouquet (Occasions), Hardwood Background, Gorgeous Grunge, Butterfly Basics, various sentiments

Ink: So Saffron, Calypso Coral, Baked Brown Sugar

Paper: Crumb Cake, So Saffron, Calypso Coral, Crisp Cantaloupe, Wild Wasabi, Whisper White

Punches: Pansy, Petite Petal, Cupcake Builder, Bitty Butterfly (optional)

Other: Big Shot, Labels Collection Framelits, Flower Frenzy Bigz die, Two-Way Glue Pen, dimensionals

## Directions:

- 1) Score card base at 5-1/2" mark on the Simply Scored Tool. Fold then crease with bone folder.
- 2) Using the Crumb Cake layer piece, stamp either the Hardwood Background or the bamboo background image from Build a Bouquet in Baked Brown Sugar ink. Adhere to card base.
- 3) Die cut the leaves from Flower Frenzy die with Wild Wasabi piece. Cut into 2 branches and adhere to wood stamped layer in left hand corner.
- 4) Punch (2) Pansy from So Saffron, Punch (2) Petite Petal in Whisper White, Punch (3) Petite Petal in Calypso Coral. Stamp the Pansy with So Saffron and the image from Build a Bouquet. Stamp Whisper White Petite Petals in So Saffron with Build a Bouquet Photopolymer dots image, Stamp Calypso Coral Petite Petals in Calypso Coral with rubber Gorgeous Grunge dots.
- 5) Using bone folder, curl the Pansy petals and adhere to stamped wood layer over leaves. Using bone folder or piercing mat and stylus curl the leaves of Petite Petal pieces. Adhere Whisper White petals to center of So Saffron Pansy. Adhere Calypso Coral Petals to wood layer. Use Cupcake Builder punch and punch dots in Crisp Cantaloupe and So Saffron. Adhere dots to flower centers with two way glue pen and tweezers. Note: all flowers are adhered with SNAIL or your other favorite glue.
- 6) Using a 2-1/4" strip of Crisp Cantaloupe...stamp with desired sentiment and die cut with second smallest Label Collection Framelit. Sponge around edges with Calypso Coral ink and adhere to wood layer with two dimensionals.
- 7) If you want butterflies – stamp the bitty butterfly image from Butterfly Basics with either Crisp Cantaloupe or So Saffron ink on a coordinating paper scrap. Punch out with the Bitty Butterfly punch and adhere to card. Add rhinestones if you wish.
- 8) Decorate inside of cards (using available sentiments and texts) and envelopes as desired.
