

Wedding Dots and Wreath Card

Supplies & Measurements:

Stamps: Wondrous Wreath, Dots for Days (background stamp)

Inks: Rose Red, Versamark (you can use Whisper White Craft Ink too)

Paper: Whisper White, Rose Red, Blackberry Bliss Cardstock & Dazzling Diamonds Glimmer Paper

Punches: Itty Bitty Accents Pack - heart, 1-3/4" Circle, Curvy Corner Trio (Holiday Catalog)

Tools & Adhesives:

Big Shot, Magnetic Platform, Wonderful Wreath Framelits, Snail, Fine Tip Liquid Glue Pen, dimensionals

Card base is Rose Red that is 4-1/4" wide by 11" long and folded in half. Stamp the front with Dots for Days background stamp in Rose Red classic ink. Punch all four corners with the Curvy Corner Trio Punch (holiday catalog).

Die cut the Joy in Whisper White (from the Wonderful Wreath Framelit collection).

Punch circle from Blackberry Bliss (1-3/4" Circle Punch)

Punch small heart (itty bitty accents punch pack) from Dazzling Diamonds Glimmer Paper

Wreath:

Stamp the wreath image from Wondrous Wreath in Whisper White or Versamark on Rose Red cardstock. Sprinkle Whisper White embossing powder over the wet ink and heat emboss with a heat tool. Die cut with the Wreath die from Wonderful Wreath Framelit set.

Assemble:

Adhere Blackberry bliss circle to card front (hold wreath over card front to determine placement). Place the die cut wreath above it on dimensionals.

Adhere glimmer heart with a half dimensional.

Use Fine Tip Glue Pen to add glue to the back of the Joy die cut. Let sit for a minute then press down to the card front.
